## 2013 The Year of Compliance

Both OSHA and HIPAA rules will require action this year to meet their requirements.

As of January 25, 2013, Department of Health & Human Services finalized the modifications to HIPAA by releasing the Omnibus HIPAA Ruling which can be found at:

<http://www.hhs.gov/ocr/privacy/hipaa/administrative/index.html>

This document finalized changes including a requirement for covered entities to write: new Notice of Privacy Practices, Policies and Procedures, Business Associate contracts and change their Breach Notification determination methods. Compliance date for this new standard is **September 23, 2013**.

Occupational Safety and Health Administration, OSHA, revised the Hazard Communication Standard in March, 2012. The new Standard requires employer to acquire new Safety Data Sheets by 2016 but to train employees on the new requirements by **December 1, 2013**.

Recently, the South Carolina State Board of Dentistry emailed their summer newsletter. Just in case you did not receive or overlooked the email, please note several items in their newsletter that will serve as a topic of interest.

**Prescription Writing:** Dentists are sometimes asked to write prescriptions that are outside the scope of practice. Do note that licensees and registrants should adhere to the Dental Practice Act regarding prescription writing. Dentists are only

allowed to prescribe within the scope of dentistry to a registered patient within their dental practice.

Please refer to the Section 40-15-70 (2- c) and 40-15-360 of the Dental Practice Act.

**Infection Control:** Infection control practices have recently come under scrutiny following revelations in Oklahoma. Dentists and dental hygienists are reminded to review and examine office practices regarding infection control. Proper guidelines and standards can be found on the ADA website. You may also refer to Board Regulation 39-10.

**Botox and Other Injectables:** Botox and fillers have become popular in recent years. The South Carolina State Board has a policy on the limitations of use and delivery of these products and injectables by licensees. The policy can be found on the website under Laws/Policies [www.llr.state.sc.us/pol/dentistry](http://www.llr.state.sc.us/pol/dentistry). The policy states in general that these are limited to the perioral area, must be for a dental purpose, must be performed by a licensed general dentist, and must be performed only where a bona fide dentist-patient relationship has been established.

**Social Coupon Website Use:** Social coupon website use is another growing practice. The Code of Ethics in Regulation 39-11, 1-H of the S. C. Code of Regulations states "Dentists shall not accept or tender 'rebates' or 'split fees.'" This includes social coupon website applications. Please be mindful of this section. A violation of the Principles of Ethics as promulgated in the Code of Regulations is grounds for misconduct.

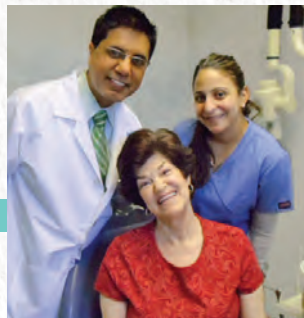

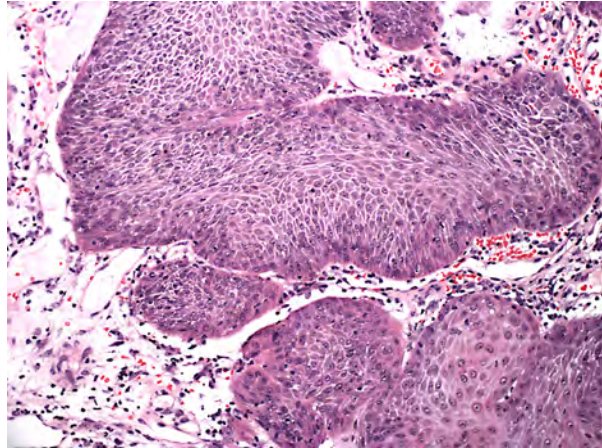

## Answer to Oral Pathology Quiz on page 8

**Diagnosis:** E. Squamous cell carcinoma



An incisional biopsy of the lesion was obtained, which showed marked cellular atypia within the surface epithelium. In addition, multiple islands and cords of malignant squamous epithelial cells could be seen infiltrating into the underlying connective tissue (Fig. 2).

Squamous cell carcinoma is the most common cancer of the mouth, accounting for approximately 90% of all oral and oropharyngeal malignancies. The most common intraoral sites are the lateral tongue and floor of the mouth. Oropharyngeal carcinomas most frequently involve the lateral soft palate / tonsillar region and the base of the tongue. Both oral and oropharyngeal squamous cell carcinoma are often associated with a history of smoking or heavy alcohol use. Previous infection with high-risk strains of human papillomavirus (HPV) has recently been identified as a significant factor for carcinomas of the oropharynx, contributing to possibly 60% of these malignancies. However, no strong association has been established for HPV infection in the pathogenesis of carcinomas of the oral cavity proper.

Because the gingiva is a less common site for oral carcinoma, it is easy for the clinician to overlook this possibility in the differential diagnosis of gingival lesions. Compounding this problem is the fact that such cancers often mimic other more common reactive gingival changes such as gingivitis/periodontitis, pyogenic granuloma, etc. Therefore, it is important for the clinician to maintain a high index of suspicion for any unexplained oral mucosal alteration, regardless of its location.

Treatment for oral cancer is best accomplished via a team approach, which often includes the contributions of the head and neck surgeon, radiation oncologist, medical oncologist, oral and maxillofacial surgeon, pathologist, radiologist, speech therapist, and maxillofacial prosthodontist. Most gingival carcinomas are treated primarily with wide surgical excision. Depending on the size of the primary tumor and status of regional lymph nodes, management may also include adjunctive radiation therapy and chemotherapy. The overall five-year survival rate ranges from 50% to 60%.
