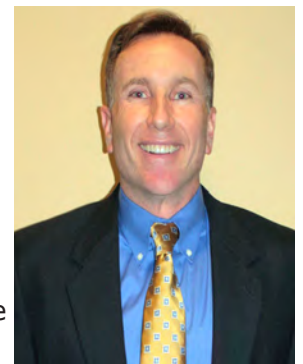

It is certainly a privilege to announce the 2013 SCDA Award Winners recognized at the Annual Session Awards Luncheon in Myrtle Beach, and none better to start with than our George P. Hoffman, Jr. Distinguished Dentist Award winner, Dr. H. Lee Gardner. Having graduated first in the MUSC College of Dental Medicine Class of 1973, Lee has never looked back over the past 40 years while practicing in Hartsville, and now is honored for his outstanding service to the SCDA, the dental profession and his community. Dr. Doug Rawls wrote in his nominating letter that "he has been an exemplary member of the dental profession, with his dental practice and everyday life conducted in the highest ethical standards."

Lee is a member of the OKU honorary dental fraternity, the SC Academy of Dental Practice Administrators, a Fellow of the Pierre Fauchard Academy, The American College of Dentists, and The International College of Dentists. He ascended through the chairs of the Pee Dee District Dental Society and our South Carolina Dental Association culminating with his being our 131<sup>st</sup> President in 2002. He served on the ADA Council on Dental Practice from 2007-2011 and is currently a Delegate to the ADA representing the dentists of South Carolina and the 16<sup>th</sup> ADA District, as well as serving as the current Chairman of the SCDA Member Benefits Group.

An accomplished pilot and marksman, Lee has not limited his life to just dentistry. He has served his community as Chairman of the Hartsville Airport Advisory Board and the Metro Board of Directors of the Upper Pee Dee YMCA, as well as President of the Hartsville Lions Club. He is a member of Saint Luke United Methodist Church and has served as Chairman of its Administrative Council and Stewardship Committee, as well as leading small group bible studies. Lee has volunteered in the Kairos Prison Ministry and Appalachian Service Program through his church as well as the Christmas in April Program in Hartsville. Lee and his wife Bonnie reside in Lydia (just below Hartsville), they have two daughters and two grandchildren.

The Meritorious Achievement Award was presented to Dr. Jeff Laro for his organization of the MUSC Student Mentoring Program. A practicing periodontist and part time faculty at MUSC, Jeff felt the need to connect dental students with a mentor practitioner in the Greater Charleston area. The program has been a big hit with the students and their mentors, and Jeff continues to lead this effort. ## Answer to the Oral Pathology Quiz on Page 5

### Diagnosis: D. Idiopathic osteosclerosis

The term idiopathic osteosclerosis refers to focal areas of increased bone density, which are of unknown cause. Also known as dense bone islands, such lesions are most common in teenagers and young adults, usually being discovered as an incidental finding when radiographs are taken for some other purpose. Idiopathic osteosclerosis is estimated to develop in approximately 5% of the population, and no significant sex predilection has been noted.

Radiographically, the lesion typically appears as a well-defined, homogeneous radiopacity ranging from 3 mm to 2 cm in greatest diameter. Occasional cases may show variable degrees of opacity within the lesion. However, no radiolucent rim can be identified. About 90% of cases occur in the mandible, with a predilection for the first molar and second premolar region. In rare examples, root resorption or tooth movement has been noted.

Idiopathic osteosclerosis often is confused radiographically with condensing osteitis. However, condensing osteitis refers to the formation of reactive bone in response to an inflammatory stimulus – most frequently from an adjacent nonvital tooth. In idiopathic osteosclerosis, no obvious source of inflammation or irritation can be identified to explain the sclerotic bony changes. Biopsy of the lesion will reveal the presence of dense lamellar bone. However, because the diagnosis can often be made with reasonable certainty on a clinical/radiographic basis, biopsy may not be necessary in many cases.

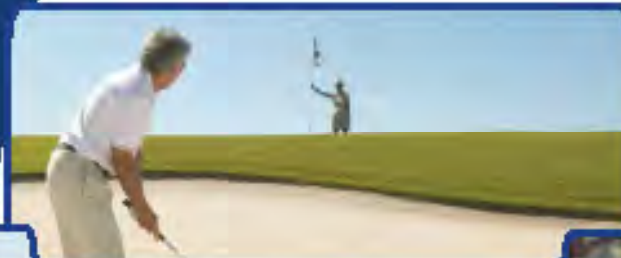
